## SAAD Camiguin oversees 1st payao project under SAAD, administers test fishing

CATARMAN, Camiguin (Feb. 14) - Together with its beneficiaries, the Provincial Fisheries Office of Camiguin (PFO-Camiguin) and the Camiguin Philippine Coast Guard Station, conducted a successful test fishing operation on Punta Catarman Community Fishing Association's payao project under the Special Area for Agricultural Development (SAAD) Program Phase 2, this town. The test fishing, led by SAAD's Provincial Program Management Support Office (PPMSO) in Camiguin, aimed to determine the daily catch derived from the payao and equate its results to the economic contribution to the fisherfolk beneficiaries.
