

Shellfish Bulletin No. 02 Series of 2024

25 January 2024

Shellfishes collected and tested from coastal waters of Danis and Tagbilaran City in Bohel; Dumanquittes Bay In Zamboanga del Sur; Lianga Bay in Surigao del Sur; and coastal waters of San Benite in Surigao del Norte are still positive for Paralytic Shelifish Poison (PSP) or toxic red tide that is beyond the regulatory limit. Moreover, coastal waters of Milagros In Masbate, San Pedro Bay in Samar and Matarinao Bay in Eastern Samar are now positive for PSP.



All types of shelifish and Acotes sp. or alamang gathered from the areas shown above are NOT SAFE for human consumption. Fish, squids, shrimps, and crabs are safe for human consumption provided that they are fresh and washed thoroughly, and internal organs such as gills and intestines are removed before cooking.

The following areas continue to be FREE from taxic red tide: coastal waters of Cavite, Las Pries, Parariegue, Navotas. Bulacan, and Batsan (Mariveles, Limay, Orion, Pitar, Balanga, Hermosa, Oroni, Abucay, and Samai) in Manile Bay: mariculture areas in Infanta, coastal waters of Bolingo, Anda, Afaminos, Sunt, and Waws, Bani in Pangasinan; manculture areas in Rosario, and Sto. Tomas in La Union; coastal waters of Pampanga; Mesinfor Bay in Zambales; Pagbilao Bay, Pagbilao, and coastal waters of Watay, Padre Surges in Quezon; Honda, and coastal waters of Inner Malampieya Sound, Taytay in Palawan; coastal waters of Mandaun in Masbete; Sorsogon Bay, and Juag Lagoon, Matalog in Sorsogon; coastal waters of Borongon, San Dionisie in Soilo; Saplan Bay (Ivisan and Saplan in Capiz; Mambuquian and Camanol, Batan in Aklan); coastal waters of Altavas, Batan, and New Washington in Batan Bay. Aidan; coastal waters of Pontevedra; Panay; Pilar; Rous City and President Roxes in Capit; coastal waters of E.B. Magalona, Talisay City, Silay City, Bacolod City, Hinlgaran, and Victorias City in Negros Occidental; Tambobo, and Sixt Bays, Station; and Bals Bay, Bals Oty in Negras Oriental; coastal waters of Daram, Calbayog, and Zumarrage, Maqueda and Villamal Bays in Semer; coestel waters of Leyte, Calubian, Ormoc, Sogod, Carigara Bey in Leyte; Tantanang Bay In Zamboanga Sibugay; Murcletagos Bay In Zamboanga del Norte and (Sapang Dalaga, and Ballangao) in Misamis Occidental; Panguil Bay, Tangub City, and coastal waters of Ozamiz City in Misamis Occidental; coastal waters of Barby in Lanzo del Norte; Taguines Lagoon, Benoni, Mahinog in Carniguin; Balite, and Pujeda Bays, Mati City in Davoo Oriental; Tagabuli Bay and Malalag Bay in Davao Occidental and Davao del Sur; coastal waters of Hinatuan, and Cortes, and Sielig Bay in Surigan del Sur.
